The teen dance was a big success along with the Monastery Raid. All the tournaments went well. We had a total attendance of 280. Broken down 130 adults, 24 youths, 23 children, 17 comp , 86 day trippers minus the receipts is \$3,494 plus a 34 dollar refund from trash. All in all, things went well. A few minor problems but nothing to report. Except the conflict in scheduling.

### Stormgod 2019

The event is completed. There are three new champions of armored combat, rapier combat, and equestrian. I do not yet have attendance numbers for the event. Financial information:

There are no outstanding payments due to vendors or the property owner.

I have approximately \$75.00 in outstanding receipts for printing and flagging tape for marking the site. There are other receipts that need to be submitted by Hlutwige for the Friday party, for waterbearing from Kata and Refskegg, and some for propane and other costs from Baron Duncan. Incidents:

There was only one incident or injury on site that I am aware of and it was a mild dog biting incident that occurred on Saturday night. Abrasions from the dog's teeth were treated on site and the dog and the person appeared to be well after the incident.

Feedback:

Five items.

Merchants request in future events held on site that the angle of the sun in the afternoon be considered with regards to their site placement.

Requests from multiple individuals were made regarding the reservation of eric and land space, and they would prefer that reservations could be made in the future by household and not simply by branch.

Comments were made that dogs on site should be leashed, and that their handlers should be sober and in control of their pets outside of their camp.

Many individuals appreciated the reduction in drinking and the overall family friendliness of events on both Friday and Saturday. They encourage similar attempts to lower the level of drinking during eric parties and any Race for the Hoard in the future.

In the future, we may want to investigate segregating "game stations" with alcohol from those without. Perhaps using the eric and eric ropes as a dividing line.
